Process :

Conducting NAS Exam at Block level by the DIET Faculties

- A sample of 80 schools from Sivagangai District and maximum 45 students from each sampled school had been included in main survey.
- It was planned to study the achievement levels of students of Class X from government, government-aided and private schools in the subjects–English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science and Modern Indian Language (MIL) and to study the difference in achievement levels with regards to area, gender, social group, board and management of schools.
- Survey was conducted and the data's were collected and sent to SCERT, Chennai.
